Window Energy rating: a plea from the fenestration industry

EuroWindoor initiated the working group on Energy Rating in 2010 consisting of all stake-holders from the fenestration industry, such as glass makers, framing materials, glaziers and solar-shading manufacturers.

Six meetings took place in the efforts of developing a position on a possible European Windows Energy Rating scheme under the Energy Labelling Directive (2010/30/EU). EuroWindoor welcomes the European Commission's will to work towards an energy rating and subsequent labelling of window and emphasizes that one single rating scheme is needed across Europe and has to take into account the different climate conditions and building design all over the continent.

A set of parameters, e.g. reference buildings to reflect the building design of standard climatic conditions, needs to be adopted and will enable the rating. Windows are complex products and many variables affect their very precise performance. For this reason, it must be acknowledged that a label will need to find the right balance between perfect accurate science and practicability.

A European Windows Energy Rating should be evolutive to allow for reevaluation to reflect market developments in the different market situations.

EAA and EuroWindoor therefore support some additional research with the EU WINners project.

Position on ECO-LABEL



EuroWindoor is against the principle of ECO labelling and is supporting Environmental Product Declarations (EPD). More info in the position paper on ECO Label released in March.

Contact with DG Environment for eco labelling and Green Public Procurement (GPP)

A delegation from EuroWindoor met Mr. Pavel Misiga, Head of unit Economic Recovery and Sustainable Production and Mrs. Alenka Burja from DG Environment on July 1st. Their main intent is to stimulate the industry to use more environment friendly methods and achieve a better performance.

Instruments are the Eco design directive, GPP criteria and Eco labelling. The EuroWindoor positions have been presented and a discussion on key factors of cooperation took place. Mrs. Burja invited the participants to contribute to the revision of the GPP windows product sheet which is likely to come in about 2 years.

EuroWindoor meeting with EC DG Enterprise

EuroWindoor met Mr.
Tapani Mikkeli, Deputy
Head of Unit Construction, DG Enterprise on
October 27th. He informed about the
revised proposal for construction
Products Regulation (CPR) adopted
by the EC.

The basic idea for revising CPD to CPR was the simplification of rules and having a harmonised technical language with comparable results on a voluntarily basis.

However, the situation became more complex as EP and EC agreed on a mandatory approach.

EuroWindoor presented the position on CPR – STD as well as the position on energy rating.

CPR has now been agreed in the second reading and will be voted on in the plenary meeting of the European Parliament on January 18th, 2011.

Energy related labelling of household appliances is a very successful story and it is likely that it will also be effective for other products

— such as

windows. On October 27th an appointment with Mrs. Villö Lelkes, Policy Officer DG Energy took place. It proved to be a chance to explain the complexity of windows and the will of EuroWindoor to contribute to the development of a label. Mrs. Lelkes informed that DG Energy is mainly working on the implementation

of the Energy Labelling Directive and the Eco Design Directive. It is expected that windows are among the first energy related products that will be labelled.

EuroWindoor offers to use the EU WINners project to develop the rating scheme. This will be checked by DG Energy.

Mrs. Lelkes agreed that a speaker from DG Energy will be available for the EuroWindoor Conference in March 2011 and inform on the Energy Labelling Directive and its expansion to energy relevant building components.

EuroWindoor Conference 2011 - "Climate Protection with new Windows"



EuroWindoor is the organizer of the conference on "Climate Protection with new Windows" on March 23rd, 2011 in Brussels. The aim of the event is to create a contact and information platform for window, door and curtain wall manufacturers acting in Europe as well as representatives of associations on national and European level and politicians involved in decision making within the European Union.
